Set up in 2002, the Ensemble "U. Giordano" has played concerts and made tours in Italy, Israel, Korea, Turkey, Sweden, Lithuania, India, and has already defined tours

in the United States, Central Europe and China. The ensemble and their components, internationally famous musicians, have recorded with Velut Luna (Padua), Bongiovanni (Bologna), BMG Ricordi, Dynamic, Tactus and many others record companies. They

have also a prestigious didactic activity, teaching in Universities such as Conservatorio "U. Giordano", Conservatorio "V. Bellini", Conservatorio "G. Nicolini" in Italy, Sungshin women's University in Seoul (South Korea) and many others.
